What's import replacement, you ask? This a short guide to help you fill out this survey, which has four major questions: two about the products you purchase and two about the services you purchase.

- **Products** might include furniture, clothing, canned food, ingredients, equipment, fuel, paper, materials such as compost or timber or seeds...
- **Services** might include insurance, banking, contractors, plowing, excavating, gardening, waste removal...
- If you do not know if the products and services you buy are produced in the Berkshires (locally) you can just write the name of the business you buy them from.
- If you do not know if the business that you buy from is based on Berkshire, then you can just write the name of the business.
- If you do not have exact numbers for how much you spend each year on certain products or services that's ok! Please estimate to the best of your ability. This will give us a sense of the amount of demand for certain products and services.

At the end of the survey we ask you to provide details about your business such as your address, number of employees and estimated revenue. This information will give us some context for your answers and help us as we analyze the survey results; they will not be shared publicly. Please share if you can.
